by the kind youngest daughter

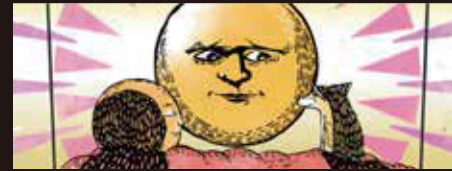
of the fox and survived the cruel
